
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2. Suggest for Purchase Improvements

In most cases, the system will pre-determine the users email address and fill this in automatically. If this is not the case, users will be required to fill in their email address to continue.

3. Patron Driven Acquisition – Suggest for Purchase

It is now possible to set up PDA via number of suggestions received. Administrators can choose to automatically purchase a title after a set number of suggestions. This can be set up in the Admin Portal alongside the other PDA options – rentals and previews.




4. Alert System



5. Aesthetic Enhancements

- The whole area surrounding a title is now clickable. Previously users had to click on the jacket image or title link.


