

2. New Features

2.1 IP Access

Institutions can now authenticate via IP alone for dawsonera. If users wish to access personalisation features, such as print, copy, notes, add to favourites etc. they will be presented with the option to login or create a new account.

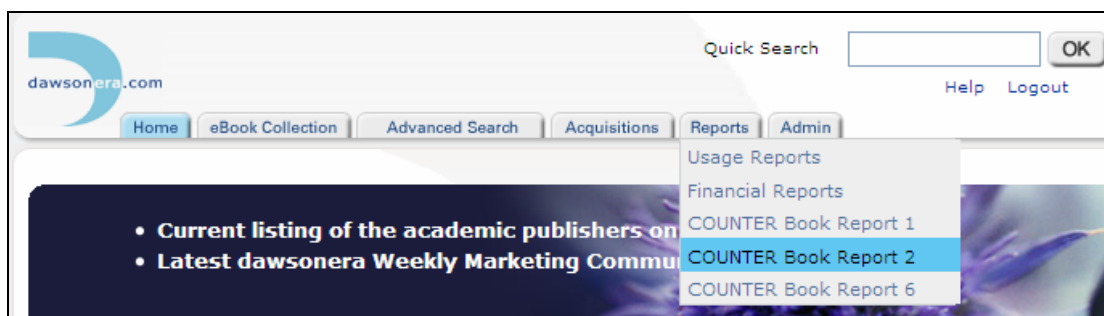
Users created during IP access sessions can be managed in the Admin Portal as normal.

The dawsonera credit system will remain in place for IP authentication. Each credit will last for the session or for 24 hours maximum.



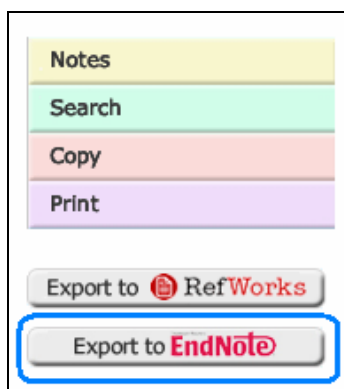

2.3 EndNote

In addition to RefWorks, users can also export information to EndNote.

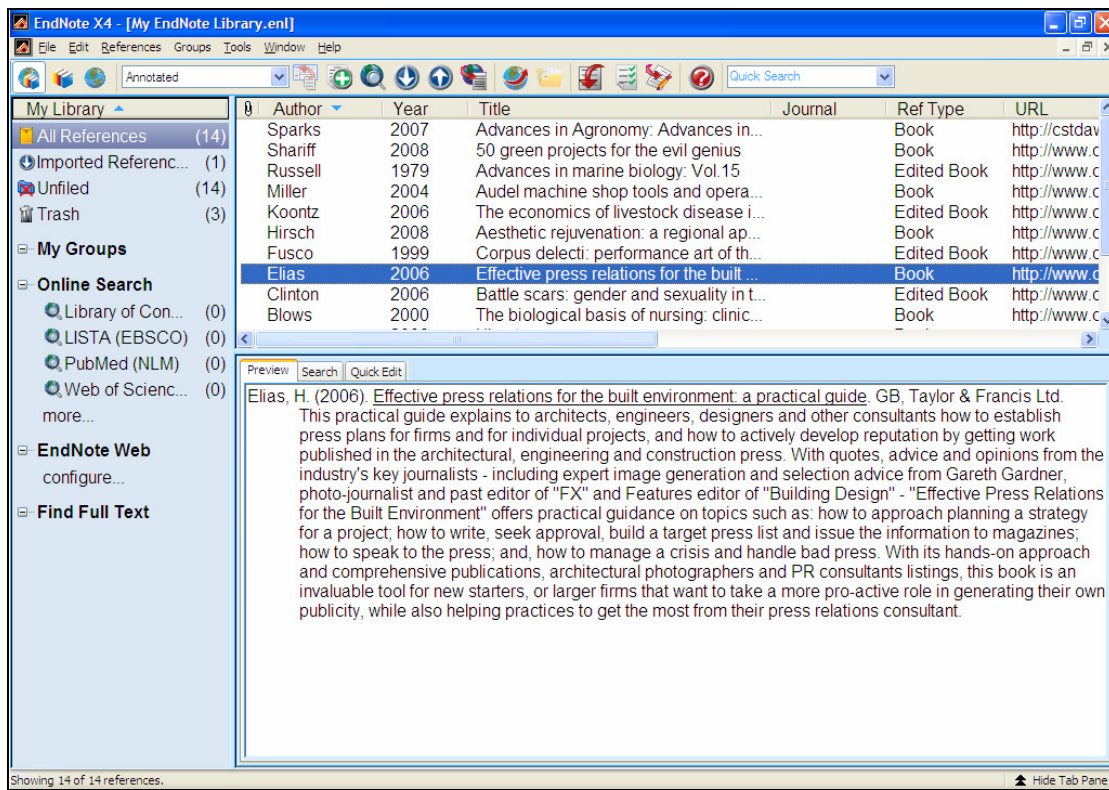
EndNote is a website citation manager. It is designed for managing references and retrieving bibliographic information. Users are able to store their reference database within EndNote.

Whilst reading online, users can click on Export to EndNote.



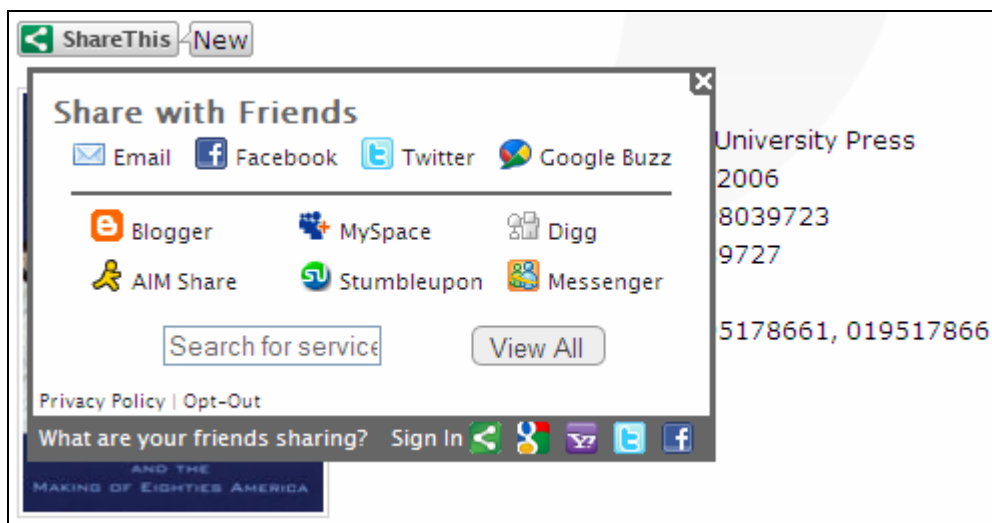
Clicking this will present users with an option to save or open the file. Users need to click on open with and select EndNote.EXE as the program.

The information will then be exported to EndNote.

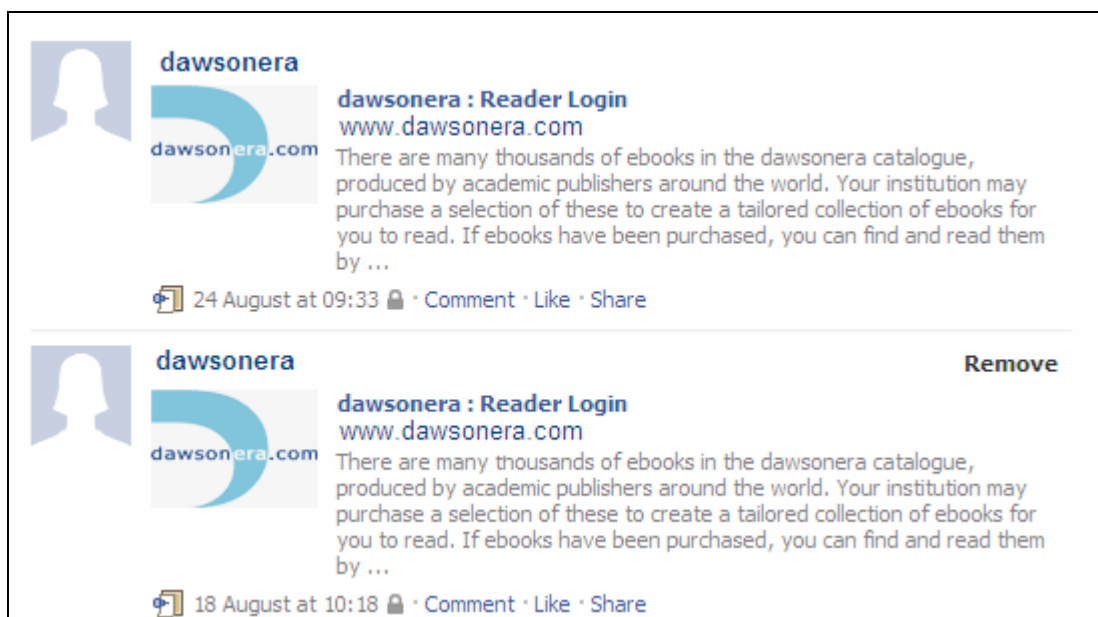


2.4 Share This

Users can now share eBooks over a variety of social networks, including Facebook, Twitter and Google Buzz.



Users just need to click on the Full Title Display of their chosen book and click on the Share This button. They then select the network and login. The example below shows the wall of a Facebook user.



2.5 Rentals - Maximum auto-approval price

An additional field has been added to the Reader Portal Configuration to allow a maximum price to be set per title for auto-approved rentals.

To enable this feature, login to the Admin Portal and navigate to the Admin tab and then Reader Portal Configuration. Enter the maximum price you will allow per rental and click save.

3. Enhancements

3.1 eBook Collection

A number of changes have been made to the eBook Collection view in the Admin Portal. Administrators can now see the number of copies purchased, the original number of credits, as well as those remaining and the fund codes associated with a title.

If there are multiple fund codes for one title, this will display on two separate lines.

3.2 Usage Report

The new usage report shows how the credits decrement over time, logging each credit as it's used. The information on how the credits decrement over time was not available prior to this release and this will be denoted with an asterisk. Any entry with an asterisk next to the number will be displaying the latest number of credits remaining.

Admin Portal users can check their usage statistics to see the number of pages accessed per title and the how long the user was reading the title for.
